Multicultural Festival To Be Held Nov. 4

CARE's second annual multicultural festival, which is being co-sponsored this year with Bucknell's Multicultural Affairs Office, is being held on Saturday, November 4 from 1:00-5:00 at RiverWoods in Lewisburg. It is FREE and open to the public.

Some of the featured displays include Latino cultures, China, Japan, Burma, India, Black American culture, White American culture, Europe, Africa and the Middle East. Each of these tables will sport artifacts, pictures and food samples.

The Latin Dance Corner of Bucknell University will dance in costume. Additionally, Jeremy DePrisco will perform folk/ blues music, and a local group will perform West African drumming. People will also have the chance to dance to multicultural dance music (free dance, no knowledge of any dance steps needed!).

Food samples will include Indian food, Burmese dessert, Japanese sushi rice, Puerto Rican rice and beans, tabouli, hummus and pita, a French pizza, chocolate chip cookies, an okra dish (African American), and others. Beverages will be served. These will just be small food samples, not complete meals.

There will also be a storytelling tent with tales from all over the world.
